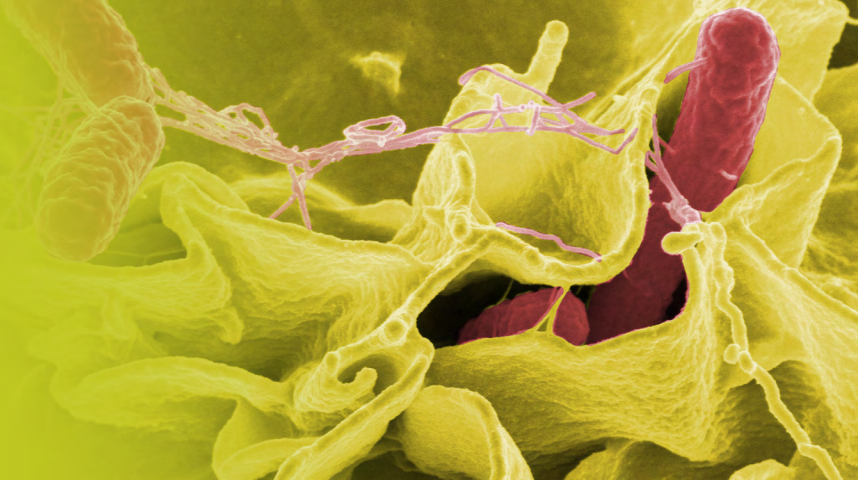


Infection Control
