STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

1. You have the right to cancel your enrollment agreement for a program of instruction, without any penalty or obligations, and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. After the end of the cancellation period, you also have the right to stop your enrollment at any time; and you have the right to receive a pro rata refund if you have completed 60 percent or less of the scheduled hours in your program through the last day of attendance. Cancellation may occur when the student at the Irvine campus provides a written notice of cancellation by mail or hand delivery at the following address: Office of the Registrar, 2041 Business Center Drive, Suite 107, Irvine, CA 92612, or by email to the Office of the Registrar at registrar@stanbridge.edu. Cancellation may occur when the student at the Alhambra campus provides a written notice of cancellation by mail or hand delivery at the following address: Student Services, 2215 W Mission Rd, Alhambra, CA 91803, or by email to the Office of the Registrar at registrar@stanbridge.edu.
3. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
4. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
5. If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled by the student before midnight of the date of cancellation, or the prospective student is not accepted for enrollment, the university will refund the student any money he/she paid, less an application fee and the value of supplies not returned in good condition for a total amount not to exceed \$150, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation.

If the program is cancelled before instruction begins, the university will refund the student any money he/she paid, less any deduction for an application fee and the value of supplies not returned in good condition for a total amount not to exceed \$150, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation.
