#### **Definitions**

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who
  were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the
  reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published
  - program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for
  - graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become
  incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or
  do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an
  accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an
  - examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.

- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school

was not able to obtain salary information.

#### STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

- 2. Cancellation may occur when the student at the Irvine campus provides a written notice of cancellation by mail or hand delivery at the following address: Office of the Registrar, 2041 Business Center Drive, Suite 107, Irvine, CA 92612, or by email to the Office of the Registrar at registrar@stanbridge.edu. Cancellation may occur when the student at the Alhambra campus provides a written notice of cancellation by mail or hand delivery at the following address: Student Services, 2215 W Mission Rd, Alhambra, CA 91803, or by email to the Office of the Registrar at registrar@stanbridge.edu.
- The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
- 4. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
- 5. If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled by the student before midnight of the date of cancellation, or the prospective student is not accepted for enrollment, the university will refund the student any money he/she paid, less an application fee and the value of supplies for a total amount not to exceed \$150, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation.
- 6. If the program is cancelled before instruction begins, the university will refund the student any money he/she paid, less any deduction for an application fee and the value of supplies for a total amount notto exceed \$150, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation.
